1 (Beginning of Audio Recording.)

2 MR. O'BRIEN: My name is Ron O'Brien.

3 I'm the prosecutor here in Franklin County,

4 and I have joining me here this morning Chief

5 Quinlan, the Columbus Division of Police, and

6 a number of other officers, sergeant, and

7 detectives from the Columbus Police Cold Case

8 Squad within the Investigative Subdivision

9 headed by Deputy Chief Tim Becker who's, also,

10 joined us.

11 We're here today to announce the

12 results of an approximate six-month

13 investigation that began on December 5th when

14 I was contacted by a lawyer representing Mt.

15 Carmel Hospital.

16 At that time, he indicated a need to

17 meet that same day, a need to disclose

18 troubling information they had discovered

19 regarding a doctor who later was identified as

20 William Husel, who had administering doses of

21 fentanyl at a level that they internally

22 believed were inappropriate and not for

23 legitimate, medical purpose and which they,

24 also, believed were designed to hasten the

25 death of the patients that were being treated.
